- B. Fire Department Equipment Purchase

 Motion by Johnson, seconded by Davis, to approve \$15,000 for the purchase of new fire hoses and turnout gear.

- Tom Richards (Resident, 789 Pine Rd.) asked about potential expansion of walking trails.
- Sarah Miller (Local Business Owner) thanked the board for their support of the downtown business association.

- Davis thanked residents for their participation in township events.
